Congratulations on being accepted by your local Rotary Club to attend the RYLA Camp at the YMCA of the Rockies in Estes Park, Colorado.

You or your Rotary Club is responsible for transportation to and from the YMCA Center in Estes Park, Colorado. Participants should plan to arrive after 2:00 pm and no later than 4:00 pm on Sunday, July 26, 1987 and will be dismissed shortly after 10:00 am Friday, July 31, 1987. Registration will begin at 4:00 pm with supper at 5:30 pm and the first program is at 7:00 pm.

The YMCA Center is located southwest of downtown Estes Park. From the main intersection, Elkhorn Avenue and Moraine Avenue in downtown Estes Park, take Moraine Avenue or Highway 66 south about two miles to Beaver Point where there is a YMCA Center sign. Take Spur 66 in a southwesterly direction just over 2 miles and turn right into the YMCA Center. Report to the administration building to find where the RYLA Camp will be registering. Participants will be staying at Howard Lodge.

Parents, friends and Rotarians are welcome to visit at any time. Mealtimes are: breakfast-7:30 am; lunch-noon; supper-5:30 pm. Meal reservations must be made 2 hours in advance.

Some of the scheduled speakers include, Congressman Hank Brown; Freedoms Foundation from Valley Forge, Pennsylvania; Natalie Meyer, Secretary of State for Colorado; Randy Gradishar, President of Denver Broncos Youth, Robert N. Miller, U. S. Attorney for Colorado; and others. All the speakers will have an interesting message and there will be time for group or individual sporting events and nature programs.

As you prepare for Camp RYLA, please again review the camper information booklet you received. Make sure you bring what you need to have an enjoyable week.
